Welcome



- Keeping the boys safe
 - A risk assessment has been pulled together for each section
 - We have been working together with both the Church and BB HQ with the Church having to approve and sign off the risk assessments for each section
 - We are following all of the Government advice and regulations for the youth sector, along with the BB and Church Framework
 - At this time, BB Scotland have only approved a return to OUTDOOR face to face activities.
 - Any boy who is or has been shielding or is nervous about coming back should please let us know privately
 - As with everything the information and dates in this presentation are subject to change

Staged Approach

A key part of our framework is our **Staged Approach** to returning to face-to-face activities, which is flexible and will provide clarity to Companies over what activities should be taking place at any given time.

As an organisation we will move through these stages in line with current Government and Youth Sector guidance, although **we may operate at different stages across England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales at any point in time**. Please note flexibility includes the possibility that we may need to return to a previous stage.



Welcome (cont.)



- Outdoor Activities
 - Please ensure that all boys have appropriate clothing for outdoor activities
 - There will be no toilet facilities during the outdoor sessions
- Uniform
 - Until further notice boys will not need uniform
 - Please do not buy any uniform
 - We will put a uniform order in when we are going reintroduce it

Enrolment and Finance



- Registration
 - Will be done online through the BB parent portal as well as annual forms being posted through your door.
 - Registration fee will be £21 and can be paid online
 - This fee is to cover the insurance for the boys and is paid directly to BB HQ
- Finance
 - To help the company we have been successful in applying for several grants
 - This is to help with the purchase of cleaning supplies, PPE and COVID ready first aid kits and other expenses
 - No subs will to be paid until we return to indoor face to face BB activities indoors
 - When this changes it will be communicated in advance

Anchors



- Will be returning to Face to Face activities
 - These sessions will take place outdoors, weather permitting
 - Once the nights start getting too dark we will move to at home activities and will periodically send out activity packs for the boys to do
- The session will be made up of games, crafts and adventures

Junior Section



- Will initially be virtual as a result of the feedback from the Risk assessment
- The activities will be from the BB@Home packs along with the new BB virtual program and they will be more active and enjoyable
- Anything required will be delivered to the boys before the session

Company Section



- Hope to return to face to face activities on Friday 11th September
- As per guidance everyone will need to maintain a 2m social distance
- The company will be split into 2 groups (maximum 15 people) which will be held at the same time and both groups will meet on either side of the park
- Neither of the groups/ officers will be allowed to integrate
- Should circumstances change that would not allow us to meet outdoor we will return to virtual sessions on 11th September.

Points to Note



- Boys and Leaders will not attend the session if they have any of the symptoms of COVID-19
- All Leaders and Boys will have their temperature checked at the beginning of the session and any person with an adversely high temperature will be segregated for 10 minutes and a second temperature will be taken
- If the 2nd temperature is still too high then the boy or officer will need to be collected
- If any boy requires additional support to partake in the planned activities this support will need to be provided by someone from the same household
- No tuck / sweets / drinks will be provided by BB's so any refreshments required are to be provided by parents / guardians - the leaders will stagger times when breaks are taken

Access and Egress



- All parents/ guardians must not socially mingle or gather whilst either dropping off or collecting their boys
- All parents/ careers must maintain social distancing whilst waiting to collect their boys
- Where possible when collecting the boys please try not to bring any siblings of the boys

Parent Portal and Online Payments



- This year we are rolling out the BB parents portal
- This allows you to view and edit your child's information
- Due to the pandemic we are looking at other ways to accept payments so we are also allowing for the first time to pay the membership fee online
